formal dining area leading out to the pretty sheltered courtyard at the rear of the house.

To the other side is a second lounge/office space, again with its own external access.

The luxurious master suite provides more gorgeous vistas and features a roomy walk-in wardrobe and contemporary ensuite with double sinks, timber carpentry and oversized rain shower.

Two queen-sized bedrooms at the other end of the house are serviced by an equally stylish family bathroom.

Cooling is ensured via split-system air conditioning, while the home's elevated position - along with flyscreens, ceiling fans and screened louvres - allows coastal breezes to flow. Power bills, meanwhile, are negligible thanks to 6.5kW of solar panels.

A well-equipped laundry and a double remote garage with internal access complete the interior space of this beautifully presented home.

Outside, almost three acres of land provide a blank canvas and a haven for animal and birdlife. Enjoy the visiting wallabies and kookaburras, cultivate orchards and veggie patches, put in a pool or add a granny flat - there's ample room for all of them here.
