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Both living zones flow out through sliding glass doors to a shaded entertaining patio and expansive pool deck, the perfect place for sundowners as you soak up your mountain vistas. There are four bedrooms, one currently configured as an office, all serviced by a family bathroom and separate WC. The master, with its chic ensuite and walk-in wardrobe, offers panoramic views on two sides and provides sliding door access out to the pool.

Cooling is ensured through split system air conditioning, while flyscreens and ceiling fans throughout allow the coastal breezes to flow through this elevated home.

A well-equipped laundry completes the internal picture, while outside, a triplebay garage ensures ample secure parking and shed storage. There's also plenty of off-street level parking for large caravans, boats and trailers.

Landscaped gardens feature a mix of level lawns and tiered beds, tropical plants and established fruit trees. Mangos, bananas and limes all grow in abundance here, and wallabies and kookaburras are regular visitors.

A lovely firepit area, meanwhile, offers more stunning mountain views and the chance to survey the beautiful hinterland night skies.
