A spacious expanse of fenced, lawned garden, fringed by fruit trees and surrounded by bush, creates a private haven you will never want to leave.

Whether you'd prefer to lounge on your poolside daybed or entertain around the alfresco kitchen with its stunning outlook, it's easy to understand why this is one of the premier addresses in the Noosa hinterland.

Alkira sits on 2.7 acres bordered by bush reserve in a whisper-quiet cul-de-sac location just 15 minutes from Noosa's beaches, boutiques and restaurants and close to several top public and private schools.

Entered via an impressive tiled porch and black French timber doors, the home

splits into upstairs and downstairs zones, creating excellent separation for busy families.

Downstairs features four good-sized bedrooms offering garden vistas, one currently configured as an office with external access providing an easy work-from-home option. On this level is a chic family bathroom and a large media room leading out through sliding glass doors to a covered lounge deck overlooking the pool.

Upstairs, high ceilings and louvred windows maximise the coastal views and breezes, creating a sense of light and space.

A spacious master suite is orientated to capture the hinterland sunrises, boasting a walk-in wardrobe and stylish double-sink ensuite with standalone bath and shower.

The sleek black-and-white kitchen at the heart of this home provides more spectacular vistas and features stone benchtops, a sit-up island, quality appliances, pendant lighting, black sink and tapware fittings, and custom cabinetry providing ample storage space.

To one side is a spacious lounge boasting a feature wood-burning fireplace, and to the other a lovely dining room with fitted window seat and built-in storage.

The living space flows out to a spacious covered deck encompassing a barbeque kitchen and bar fridge, an idyllic spot to entertain family and friends surrounded by nature.

Stairs lead down from here to the 10×4 m heated saltwater pool, with its Mediterranean-inspired white surrounds and shaded daybed corner.

Parking at Alkira includes a shade-sailed caravan or boat bay, and a double remote garage with covered access through to the well-equipped laundry/mudroom.

A whopping 12kW solar system and 9.6kW battery storage means there are no power bills, while a 70,000L water tank including hospital-grade double filtration ensures a constant supply of pure water.

Temperature control is ensured through reverse-cycle split-system air conditioning, while ceiling fans and flyscreens throughout allow the air to circulate.

Outside, the fully fenced rear garden is a delightful mix of established trees and

expansive lawns and offers a swing set and a ton of space for kids and pets to play safely.

Four large, raised veggie beds contain organic soil ready for planting, while fruit trees deliver a regular harvest of limes, lemons, mandarins, kumquats, grapefruit and bananas, pomegranates, mulberries, cashews, apricots, avocadoes and mangoes.

And an inbuilt firepit lounge allows you to enjoy the brilliance of the coast's night skies, free of ambient light and in the privacy of your beautiful hinterland haven.
